4. The report must be turned in to me at jacquelyndwilson@gmail.com by midnight on February 29, 2012 to be judged.
5. The area officer team and advisors will judge the projects based on the planning, organization, execution and impact that it had on the community.
6. The winning district will be recognized at Area Convention and the 2011-2012 district officer team will present their detailed report to the area.
